RE: Arrangements for Schools from Friday 4 June 2021 and onwards.

Dear parents and carers,

Yesterday, the Victorian Government announced new arrangements for schools in Victoria from and including Friday 4 June.

Based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, all schools in metropolitan Melbourne will continue with remote and flexible learning until Thursday 10 June. This includes our school.

Existing arrangements for on-site supervision of vulnerable children and the children of authorised workers continue to be in place.

For Kurunjang Secondary College there is one important change to the current settings.

Students enrolled in Years 11 and 12 will return to face-to-face learning from Friday 4 June 2021, because of the importance of enabling these students to continue to complete their senior secondary certificate, either VCE or VCAL. Those Year 10 students who have VCE studies or VCAL strands in their learning program will be contacted later today by college staff to clarify their arrangements.

Remote and flexible learning for Year 7 to 10

Students enrolled in Years 7 to 10 will continue with remote and flexible learning from Friday 4 June 2021. Our teachers will continue to provide learning information online to their Year 7 to 10 students during this time through our Compass School Portal. This will include learning material and instructions to consolidate the learning that has occurred so far this year.

Students have been provided with information on how to access class work on Compass previously. Log-in details and passwords have been checked and reissued. We have placed a video tutorial on the college's website, <http://www.kurunjangsc.vic.edu.au/>, for students and parents to locate classwork on Compass.

Information is available from the Department of Education and Training (DET) to further [support your child's learning from home](#) if you wish to access it.

On-site supervision

Our school will **provide on-site supervision for students, from Monday to Thursday of next week, in the following categories:**

- Children whose parents are considered [permitted workers as listed](#), cannot work from home and where no other supervision arrangements can be made.

- Vulnerable children, including children in out-of-home care, children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm and children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service).

If you work in essential services and need to send your child to school, please contact Aylin Gokmen, the College's Assistant Principal, to confirm your child's attendance on these days. This will allow us to put appropriate arrangements in place.

Face masks

Secondary school students aged 12 or older must always wear a face mask at school, unless an exception applies. Face masks are also mandatory for all school students aged 12 or older when travelling to and from school.

Please don't hesitate to contact your child's coordinator or contact the college if you have any questions or concerns. As always, I will update our community as soon as information becomes available from DET.
