Dear parents and carers,

I am writing to families in order to provide so information about our school operations for tomorrow and next week as a consequence of the Premer's, Mr Daniel Andrews, announcement this afternoon that all Victorian schools will be moving to a five-day period of lockdown from Friday 16 July to Tuesday 20 July inclusive.

Mr Andrews also declared that tomorrow, **Friday, and next week, Monday and Tuesday, to be remote learning days for students.**

At this stage, **we plan to return to school next Wednesday 21 July 2021.**

During this period of time, the College will continue to support the wellbeing of all our students and to ensure that, as much as possible, learning continues over these three school days.

Can I also take this opportunity to emphasize the following to families:

#### **LOCKERS/SCHOOL ACCESS**

If your child requires access to their locker to retrieve essential items to assist their learning, please contact the college and make appropriate arrangements.

#### **ON-SITE SUPERVISION**

Our school will **provide on-site supervision for students, from Friday to Tuesday of next week, in the following categories:**

- Children whose parents are considered [permitted workers as listed](#), cannot work from home and where no other supervision arrangements can be made.
- Vulnerable children, including children in out-of-home care, children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm and children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service).

If you work in essential services and need to send your child to school, please contact Aylin Gokmen, the College's Assistant Principal, to confirm your child's attendance on these days. This will allow us to put appropriate arrangements in place.
