RE: Latest staged return to onsite learning

Dear parents,

We are very excited to share that the timeline for the [staged return to onsite learning](#) is being brought forward, with restrictions that were to be lifted on Tuesday 26 October now to be lifted from Friday 22 October.

This has all been made possible thanks to parents, teachers, students and the broader Victorian community stepping up to get vaccinated in great numbers across our community.

The updated Roadmap, which is based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, sets out the staged return to onsite learning in Term 4.

Remote and flexible learning will continue to be delivered to students on the days students are not onsite.

Vulnerable children and children of parents or carers who are on the authorised provider and authorised worker list can continue attending onsite as before. If you fall in these categories please contact Aylin Gokmen, the College's Assistant Principal, to confirm your child's attendance onsite. This will allow us to put appropriate arrangements in place.

As previously communicated, students in Grade 7 and above are required to wear face masks appropriately and as required both indoors and outdoors.

Thank you again for all your support and we look very much to welcoming our students back to onsite learning full time, very soon.
